## INFANT BAPTISMS

Both parents and godparents are expected to attend one catechetical session in advance, on the Wednesday before the baptism, at 7:00 pm.

## SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

Before being fully initiated into the sacramental life of the Church, **children over the age of 7** will need catechetical preparation through the RCIA process. **Teenagers** and **adults** will participate in **separate** RCIA processes.

## CONFIRMATION and COMMUNION

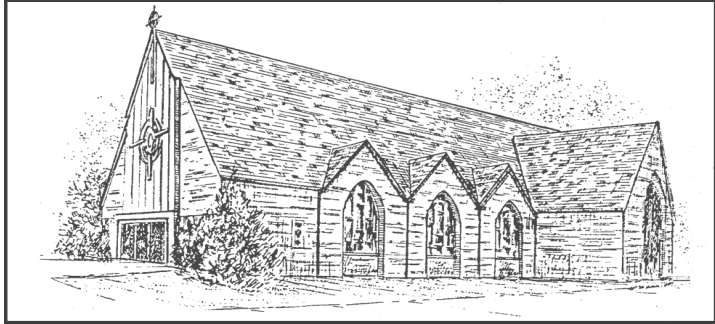

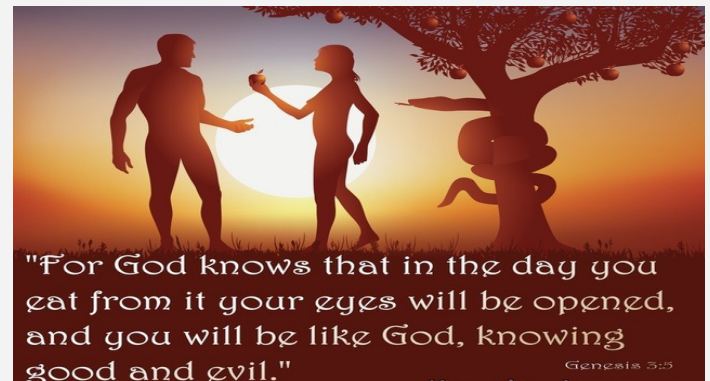
### TODAY'S READINGS

## **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:**

### **Dear Parishioners**

There were two devotions the church celebrated at the end of this past week. Friday was the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Saturday was the Immaculate Heart of Mary. In the celebration of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, we remember that the Lord loves us so much that he sacrificed himself through his earthly ministry and finally on the cross in order to save us from sin and death by his undaunted and unlimited love. In the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we remember that Mary is the perfect model of our response to Christ who gave Mary the grace to be obedient, wise, pure, steadfast, and a model for the whole church in her discipleship to Christ.

In our church, the statue of the Sacred Heart stands next to the ambo where the readings for Mass are proclaimed. The statue can remind us that God's word flows from God's infinite love for us which is emphasized in the devotion of the Sacred Heart. Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque had a vision of Jesus in 1675 during which Jesus showed her his Sacred Heart and asked that there be a feast of reparation established on the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi. In time, after examination by the church, the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was made a Solemnity and placed on the liturgical calendar. The image of the Sacred Heart has a flaming heart, pierced, bleeding, encircled by the crown of thorns with the cross on top of it. The flame reminds us of the burning, passionate, vibrant love that Jesus has for us. It is this love that the priest presents in the Holy Eucharist when he prays the Mass and gives out Holy Communion. Jesus with all his love sacrifices himself for us every time the Holy Mass is celebrated by giving his Body and Blood to us.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was celebrated on June 7th this year. The Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is also designated to be the World Day of prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. It is important that we pray that all men, who have received the call to be priests, may respond generously to this vocation. It is important to pray also that the priests of the church may fervently cooperate with the grace to become more like Christ with his Sacred Heart. We pray that the love of Christ may sanctify the hearts of all priests enabling them to grow stronger as witnesses to the love Christ is offering to all people. We can also pray for all the young people who will be confirmed this Saturday, that they may open their hearts to the Holy Spirit. Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us.

## **DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR:**

### **Queridos Feligreses**

Hubo dos devociones que la iglesia celebró al final de la semana pasada. El viernes fue el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y el sábado fue el Inmaculado Corazón de María. En la celebración del Sacratísimo Corazón de Jesús, recordamos que el Señor nos ama tanto que se sacrificó a sí mismo a través de su ministerio terrenal y finalmente en la cruz para salvarnos del pecado y de la muerte con su amor intrépido e ilimitado. En la Memoria del Inmaculado Corazón de María, recordamos que María es el modelo perfecto de nuestra respuesta a Cristo, quien le dio la gracia de ser obediente, sabia, pura, firme y un modelo para toda la iglesia en su discipulado de Cristo.

En nuestra iglesia, la estatua del Sagrado Corazón se encuentra junto al ambón donde se proclaman las lecturas de la Misa. La estatua puede recordarnos que la palabra de Dios fluye del amor infinito de Dios por nosotros, que se enfatiza en la devoción del Sagrado Corazón. Santa Margarita María Alacoque tuvo una visión de Jesús en 1675 durante la cual Jesús le mostró su Sagrado Corazón y pidió que se estableciera una fiesta de reparación el viernes después de la octava del Corpus Christi. Con el tiempo, después de ser examinada por la Iglesia, la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús se convirtió en una solemnidad y se colocó en el calendario litúrgico. La imagen del Sagrado Corazón tiene un corazón llameante, atravesado, sangrante, rodeado por la corona de espinas con la cruz encima. La llama nos recuerda el amor ardiente, apasionado y vibrante que Jesús tiene por nosotros. Es este amor el que el sacerdote presenta en la Sagrada Eucaristía cuando reza la Misa y da la Sagrada Comunión. Jesús, con todo su amor, se sacrifica por nosotros cada vez que se celebra la Santa Misa dándonos su Cuerpo y su Sangre.

La fiesta del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús se celebró el 7 de Junio de este año. La Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús también está designada como la Jornada Mundial de oración por la Santificación de los Sacerdotes. Es importante que recemos para que todos los hombres, que han recibido la llamada a ser sacerdotes, respondan generosamente a esta vocación. Es importante orar también para que los sacerdotes de la Iglesia cooperen fervientemente con la gracia de llegar a ser más como Cristo con su Sagrado Corazón. Oramos para que el amor de Cristo santifique los corazones de todos los sacerdotes, permitiéndoles fortalecerse como testigos del amor que Cristo ofrece a todas las personas. También podemos rezar por todos los jóvenes que serán confirmados este sábado, para que abran su corazón al Espíritu Santo. Nuestra Señora de Fátima, ruega por nosotros.

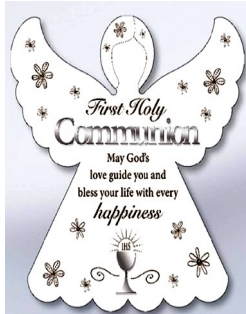

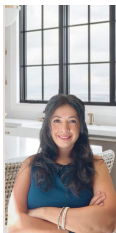
