TODAY'S READINGS

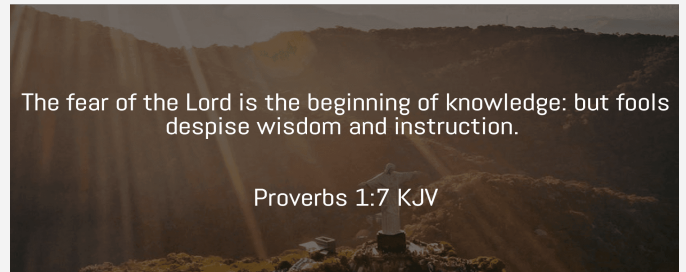
First reading - Wisdom 7:7-11: I prayed for wisdom, valuing her above riches, health, and beauty. With her, I received all good things and countless riches.

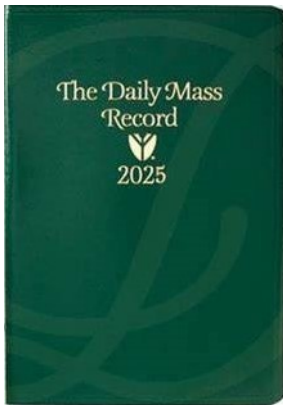

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners:

"I want to tell you that a chapel is to be built here in my honour. I am the Lady of the Rosary. Continue always to pray the Rosary every day. The war is going to end, and the soldiers will soon return to their homes." This is one of the messages that the Blessed Mother gave to the child visionaries, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco 107 years ago on October 13, 1917.

A chapel is a small place of worship that could be in a church, in a building that is not a church or standing by itself. In the Sanctuary of Fatima in Portugal, there is a chapel called the Chapel of the Apparitions which marks the place that Our Lady first appeared to the three children.

The first chapel that was built there in 1920 was destroyed by anti-religious extremists using dynamite in 1922. In 1923 a second chapel of stone replaced it. Later the Basilica of the Rosary was built nearby.

I am happy that we have our Church of Our Lady of Fatima which also has a chapel where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved. We are privileged to have a consecrated building that we can worship the Lord and be under the patronage of the Blessed Mother. When our Blessed Mother told the children that she wanted a chapel to be built, I am sure she also expected that the chapel would be maintained. If a building is not maintained or taken care of it will fall down. It also needs to resist attacks at times. c

How do we maintain the chapel and the church of Our Lady of Fatima? First, we need to make the spiritual building of our souls strong. We need to pray personally and as church. We are doing a Novena before our feast day and today, Sunday, we process outside around the church. We pray together asking for Mother Mary's help to follow her Son. Second, we need to support the church by giving monetarily in the collections and also giving of ourselves in service by sharing skills and talents. "I am the Lady of the Rosary". Mary wants us to say the rosary every day for peace and for the conversion of sinners. Those words echoed in my mind last Monday, October 7, the Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. A car went out of control, mounted the sidewalk in front of the church and crashed into the gate at the entrance of the walk way before our outside statue of Our Lady of Fatima. No one was hurt at 9am in the morning. Someone may say it was luck. I say it was a sign of the protection of Our lady of the Rosary. Thank you Our Lady of Fatima and please pray for us.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PASTOR:

Queridos Feligreses:

"Quiero decirles que aquí se va a construir una capilla en mi honor. Yo soy la Señora del Rosario. Continúen rezando siempre el Rosario todos los días. La guerra va a terminar y los soldados pronto regresarán a sus hogares". Este es uno de los mensajes que la Santísima Virgen dio a los niños videntes, Lucía, Jacinta y Francisco hace 107 años, el 13 de Octubre de 1917.

Una capilla es un pequeño lugar de culto que puede estar en una iglesia, en un edificio que no es una iglesia o que se sostiene por sí mismo. En el Santuario de Fátima en Portugal, hay una capilla llamada la Capilla de las Apariciones que marca el lugar donde Nuestra Señora se apareció por primera vez a los tres niños.

La primera capilla que se construyó allí en 1920 fue destruida por extremistas antirreligiosos que utilizaron dinamita en 1922. En 1923 la sustituyó una segunda capilla de piedra. Más tarde se construyó la Basílica del Rosario en las cercanías.

Estoy feliz de que tengamos nuestra Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de Fátima, que también tiene una capilla donde se reserva el Santísimo Sacramento. Tenemos el privilegio de tener un edificio consagrado en el que podemos adorar al Señor y estar bajo el patrocinio de la Santísima Virgen. Cuando nuestra Santísima Madre les dijo a los niños que quería que se construyera una capilla, estoy seguro de que también esperaba que la capilla se mantuviera. Si un edificio no se mantiene o no se cuida, se caerá. También necesita resistir ataques a veces.

¿Cómo mantenemos la capilla y la iglesia de Nuestra Señora de Fátima? Primero, necesitamos fortalecer la construcción espiritual de nuestras almas. Necesitamos orar personalmente y como iglesia. Estamos haciendo una novena antes de nuestro día de fiesta y hoy, domingo, procesionamos afuera alrededor de la iglesia. Rezamos juntos pidiendo la ayuda de la Madre María para seguir a su Hijo. En segundo lugar, necesitamos apoyar a la iglesia dando monetariamente en las colectas y también dándonos a nosotros mismos en servicio compartiendo habilidades y talentos.

"Soy la Señora del Rosario". María quiere que recemos el rosario todos los días por la paz y por la conversión de los pecadores. Esas palabras resonaron en mi mente el pasado lunes, 7 de Octubre, en la memoria de Nuestra Señora del Rosario. Un automóvil perdió el control, subió a la acera frente a la iglesia y se estrelló contra la puerta en la entrada del pasillo antes de nuestra estatua exterior de Nuestra Señora de Fátima. Nadie resultó herido a las 9 de la mañana. Alguien puede decir que fue suerte. Lo digo que era un signo de la protección de Nuestra Señora del Rosario. Gracias Nuestra Señora de Fátima y por favor ruega por nosotros.

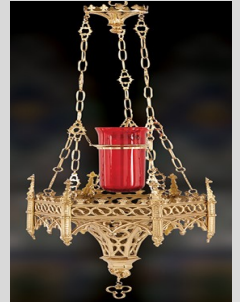

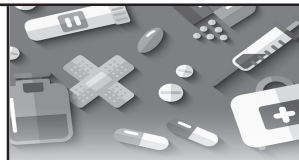
