INFANT BAPTISMS

Both parents and godparents are expected to attend one catechetical session in advance, on the Wednesday before the baptism, at 7:00 pm.

SACRAMENTS OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION

Before being fully initiated into the sacramental life of the Church, **children over the age of 8** will need catechetical preparation through the OCIA process. **Teenagers** and **adults** will participate in **separate** OCIA processes.

CONFIRMATION and COMMUNION

ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's Reading

First Reading – Exodus 19:2-6a: The Israelites arrive at Mount Sinai, where God speaks to Moses and tells him to convey a message to the people. God reminds the Israelites of how He delivered them from slavery in Egypt and declares that if they obey His commands and keep His covenant, they will be a treasured possession and a kingdom of priests.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 100: This passage is a call to all people to praise and serve the Lord joyfully, recognizing that we are His people and the sheep of His flock. The verses emphasize God's goodness, His role as creator and caretaker of His people, and His eternal kindness and faithfulness.

Second Reading – Romans 5:6-11: God showed His love for humanity by sending Jesus Christ to die for our sins while we were still sinners. Through Jesus' sacrifice, we can be reconciled with God and receive the gift of eternal life.

Gospel – Matthew 9:36-10:8: Jesus has compassion for the crowds. He decides to send out His twelve disciples to heal the sick, raise the dead, and proclaim the good news of the kingdom of heaven. Jesus instructs His disciples to freely give what they have received, encouraging them to serve others with love and generosity.

Lecturas de Hoy

Primera Lectura – Éxodo 19:2-6a: Los israelitas llegan al Monte Sinaí, donde Dios habla con Moisés y le dice que transmita un mensaje al pueblo. Dios recuerda a los israelitas cómo los liberó de la esclavitud en Egipto y declara que si obedecen Sus mandamientos y cumplen Su pacto, serán una posesión preciosa y un reino de sacerdotes.
Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 100: Este pasaje es un llamado a todas las personas a alabar y servir al Señor con alegría, reconociendo que somos Su pueblo y el rebaño de Su cuidado. Los versículos enfatizan la bondad de Dios, Su papel como creador y cuidador de Su pueblo, y Su bondad y fidelidad eternas.

Segunda Lectura – Romanos 5:6-11: Dios mostró su amor por la humanidad al enviar a Jesucristo para morir por nuestros pecados mientras aún éramos pecadores. A través del sacrificio de Jesús, podemos ser reconciliados con Dios y recibir el don de la vida eterna.

Evangelio – Mateo 9:36-10:8: Jesús tiene compasión de las multitudes. Decide enviar a sus doce discípulos para sanar a los enfermos, resucitar a los muertos y proclamar la buena noticia del reino de los cielos. Jesús instruye a sus discípulos a dar gratuitamente lo que han recibido, animándolos a servir a los demás con amor y generosidad.

Kingdom of God.

There are harvests, the fruits of having faith in Jesus
and following him in our lives. Your donations each

Our Lady of Fatima. It supports the priests who live
here in order that they may serve the community in
their different spiritual and sometimes material needs.
Your donations in the collections work to support the
structure of the buildings and grounds of the church in
which people come to pray and receive the sacraments

As we go forward into the next half of the year, let us
be the disciples of Jesus who go into the fields of the
world in our homes, work and community to announce
that the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. We can do this

call of the Lord for vocations in our families in the
